

Camp Promotional Ideas & Timeline

Concept: Have your Pack Camping Coordinator present information on Cub Camps at each pack meeting, choosing a different topic each month.

Request a district volunteer to attend a pack meeting and do a formal camp promotion in January, February or March timeframe. Contact the Scout Service Center or your district executive for more information.

- Boys who attend camp stay in Scouting longer and advance farther in the program

- Held at Camp Holaka; meals are in the dining hall; tent camping
- 1 registered adult leader for every 4 boys (minimum of 2 deep leadership)
- Swimming; paddle boats; fishing; sports games, battle for Holaka; campfire program; shooting sports;

February

Camp Planning

- Review forms, deadlines, discounts, etc.
- Encourage signing up and attending as a den and/or pack
- Promote family camps – positive camp experience may boost many parents to get more involved as a leader
- Discuss how to pay for camp with little or no out of pocket expense:
 - Popcorn Sale; Flower Power spring product sale; Camperships; Savings Accounts, etc.
