

Bike Safety Rules

1. APPROVED HELMETS ONLY, ARE REQUIRED TO BE WORN BY ALL THOSE RIDING BIKES. TROOP NUMBERS MUST BE AFFIXED TO THE HELMET IN 2-INCH HIGH NUMBERS.
2. BIKES ARE LIMITED TO CAMP ROADS ONLY. **NO RIDING ON FOOTPATHS, TRAILS, OR THE BOARDWALK!**
3. NO RIDING OFF CAMP WITHOUT THE EXPRESS PERMISSION OF THE CAMP PROGRAM DIRECTOR. YOU ALSO MUST SIGN OUT AT THE CAMP OFFICE.
4. BIKES WILL RIDE ON THE RIGHT SIDE OF ROADS. ANNOUNCE YOUR PRESENCE WHEN APPROACHING PEOPLE WALKING AND STOP FOR ANY ADULT WHO TELLS YOU TO STOP.
5. VIOLATION OF BIKE SAFETY RULES MAY BE GROUNDS FOR LOSS OF BIKING PRIVILEGES AND COULD RESULT IN REMOVAL FROM CAMP.
6. NO RIDING IN PROGRAM AREAS OR CAMPSITES. LEAVE THE BIKE OUTSIDE THE AREAS. DURING CAMP WIDE ACTIVITIES, BICYCLES WILL BE PARKED 100 YARDS AWAY FROM THE GATHERING OF SCOUTS. DURING CAMPFIRE PROGRAM, BICYCLES WILL BE PARKED NEAR THE OPEN AREAS NEAR THE MEDICAL CENTER.
7. THE TALL PINE COUNCIL ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST OR DAMAGED BIKES. **PLEASE LOCK YOUR BIKE!**
8. BIKES ARE NOT TO BE USED DURING ANY CAMP WIDE EVENT. BIKES MAY BE PARKED AT THE BIKE RACKS LOCATED IN THE PROGRAM AREA OR DESIGNATED BIKE LOTS.
- 9. BIKES ARE NOT ALLOWED TO BE USED ON SUNDAY.**
10. BIKE SAFETY ORIENTATION MUST BE COMPLETED PRIOR TO RENTING A BIKE OR USING A PERSONAL BIKE.
11. ANY DISPUTES REGARDING BIKE SAFETY WILL BE SETTLED BY THE CAMP DIRECTOR OR HIS DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE AND YOUR SCOUTMASTER.
12. BIKES MUST HAVE OWNER'S NAME AND TROOP NUMBER AFFIXED TO THE BIKE, PREFERABLE ATTACHED TO THE CENTER BAR OF THE BIKE.
13. TAPICO BIKES ARE CONSIDERED CAMP EQUIPMENT. ANY DAMAGE TO A CAMP BIKE WILL BE CONSIDERED THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE TROOP.
14. BIKES ARE NOT TO BE OPERATED AFTER DARK.
15. BIKE RIDERS MUST INSURE THEY PARK THEIR BIKES IN DESIGNATED PLACES ONLY. IF A BIKE IS PARKED IN A PLACE THAT IMPEDES THE FLOW OF TRAFFIC, IT MAY BE REMOVED AND IMPOUNDED FOR 24 HOURS BY THE RANGER SECTION.
16. IN THE EVENT OF A MEDICAL EMERGENCY, BICYCLISTS MUST YIELD TO THE HEALTH OFFICER OR OTHER MEDICAL EMERGENCY RESPONDERS.
